Training & Competition Requirements Level C Effective 29th June 2020

REQUIREMENTS

Total participants, volunteers, team officials, support staff and spectators	Unrestricted - One person per 2 square metres applies. See player and spectator map, page 3.
Social distancing	1.5 metre physical distancing
COVID Safe Officer	Michelle Collins 0414 517 303
Attendance record	Not required
Equipment	Unrestricted No sharing of whistles Shared equipment should be sanitised after each use
Breaks between sessions (to avoid co-mingling and carry out any cleaning required)	Unrestricted. Grange Courts– do not arrive more than 15 mins before scheduled timeslot.
Oranges & Lollies	Shared food (i.e. oranges, lollies and recovery food) is still considered communal food and is not permitted.
Participant arrival and departure time	Unrestricted - As determined by club/association
Training and match length	1 hour training. Competition as advised by SAUCNA
Contact and non-contact drills	Unrestricted
Other contact (end of match handshake, huddles, high fives etc)	Should seek alternatives
Hand sanitiser	Should be available in team kits, bathrooms, and clubrooms
First aid kit	Must be available in team kits
Individually labelled water bottle and hand towel	Must do

Venue – Jetty Street & Beach Street Level C Effective 29th June 2020

REQUIREMENTS

Associations/Club/Team social events at venue	As per government restrictions
Canteen/Kiosk/BBQ's	Coffee Van available on match day. Alternating Beach Street and Jetty Street where necessary.
Cleaning	Should sanitise score bench, shared equipment, and pole protectors between sessions
Toilets	Beach Street - Unrestricted Cleaned as required Jetty Street - Unrestricted Cleaned as required, located at Grange Lawn Tennis Club.
Clubrooms	Open 1.5 metre physical distancing applies One person per 2 square metres applies
Hand sanitiser	Available on Entry and Exit
Spectators – Jetty Street	For two court locations such as this one, it is recommended to have parents/guardians remain outside of the court area (fenced area). 1.5 metre physical distancing applies One person per 2 square metres applies.
Spectators – Beach Street	For two court locations such as this one, it is recommended to have parents/guardians remain outside of the court area (fenced area) where possible. We do have a top court area available for player warm up located next to court one and a car park area available for additional viewing purposes. 1.5 metre physical distancing applies One person per 2 square metres applies
Covid Safe Attendant – Game Day	Each team playing on Court 1 at Beach Street or Jetty Street will allocate an adult to wear the fluoro vest to highlight the person in charge of the requirements as listed above and chat to spectators to adhere to requirements if necessary. Or if anyone at the venue has any queries to speak to this person. Covid Safe Attendant to be aware of the location of the Covid Safe plan for each venue. Jetty Street – in Pink box in lockable bench (under shelter) Beach Street – Located in the equipment shed on the pin board inside the door.
